Report of the 2019 Committee on Elections

Indianapolis, Indiana

April 27, 2019

TO: NRA Annual Meeting of Members

The Bylaws of the Association designate the NRA Committee on Elections as being responsible for the conduct of the election of Directors. The Committee selected a leading international accounting firm to assist with the election. The Committee also selected a qualified document imaging firm to optically scan the ballots.

The detailed procedures to maintain control over the ballots, determine their validity, and assure accurate scanning and tabulation were approved by Committee members prior to the beginning of ballot tabulation. The procedures addressed compliance with required provisions of the NRA's Bylaws, and Committee members personally observed the processes performed to confirm that all requirements were being met.

The results of the 2019 Directors' election process are as follows:

A total of 2,452,813 ballots were mailed to eligible voting members of the Association for the election of twenty-five Directors for three-year terms ending in 2022 and two one-year terms ending in 2020. A total of 145,920 ballots were cast by eligible members. All ballots received were valid, except for a total of 4,819 which were judged invalid for the following reasons:

A total of 2,781 ballots included write-in votes or a combination of write-in votes and votes for candidates on the printed ballot. No write-in candidate, who was not on the printed ballot, received enough votes to be elected to the Board of Directors.

In accordance with Article VIII, Section 2, of the NRA Bylaws, as Chairman of the Committee on Elections, I declare the following persons to have been elected Directors of the

NRA for three-year terms ending in 2022 (unless otherwise specified), to take office from the adjournment of this meeting:

\*Elected to complete an unexpired term for one-year ending in 2020. The vacancy occurred when William H. Allen, a Director elected in 2017 to a three-year term, resigned in 2018. Deputy Sheriff Mark Vaughan was the candidate receiving the next highest total of votes, and was elected to complete Chief Allen's term.

\*\*Elected to complete an unexpired term for one-year ending in 2020. The vacancy occurred when Tom Selleck, a Director elected in 2017, resigned in 2018. Mr. Herbert A. Lanford, Jr. was the candidate receiving the next highest total of votes, and was elected to complete Mr. Selleck's term.

The remaining candidates on the ballot, who were not elected, are as follows:



One additional Director will be elected for a one-year term by those members present and voting at this Annual Meeting of Members. Eligible voters include not only Lifetime members and Annual members with five or more consecutive years of membership who were eligible to vote in the mail elections, but ALL Annual members present whose fully paid membership was received by the Secretary on or before March 8, 2019, who have attained the age of 18 years, and who are citizens of the United States. Candidates for election at this Annual Meeting of Members are those candidates who were nominated previously for the mail election of Directors but failed to be elected.

Voting for this additional Director began Thursday at 2:00 p.m. in the Voter Verification Room and will close today at 4:00 p.m., or upon the adjournment of this Annual Meeting of Members, whichever is later. The results will be announced at this evening's event, and will also be published in the Official Journal, along with the results of the mail ballot.
